## **Why not become an Open DAW Supporter?**

We are a small independent charity based in the foyer of the Methodist Church.

We provide a number of services to the local community from drop-in sessions with local organisations and agencies to local community event information and a monthly community litter pick.

We rely on our supporters as a key source of income to keep Open Daw running for older people, vulnerable and those in need of help whatever their circumstances.

## What does Open DAW do?

---

Since 2005 Open DAW has been helping local people find the right information or person or place to help them with their enquiry.

We hold FREE regular drop in sessions between Monday to Friday 10 am to 12 noon from a variety of organisations. These include local solicitors, to Town Councillors, Police and Community Support Officers, Assist Teignbridge, the Devon Disability Network and the Town Manager.

We are a safe and friendly environment for older people, vulnerable or those in crisis to pop in have a cup of tea and coffee and a chat.

## Keeping your community informed!

---

Open DAW updates two community noticeboards in the town on a weekly basis. These are by the waterfowl enclosure and the Co-op supermarket. Local organisations bring in or email posters for displaying on the noticeboards.

In addition the events posters are put onto the Love Dawlish website, Love Dawlish Facebook and Twitter pages and electronic noticeboards in Teignmouth and Dawlish .

Open DAW also runs its own Facebook and Twitter pages with the help of volunteers.

## Out and about in your community!

---

Open DAW organises other community activities. On the last Saturday of each month we organise a community litter pick in Dawlish. About 20 volunteers go out in their yellow tabards and with litter picking tools collect all manner of litter from around the town.

Over the years it has made a considerable impact on keeping the town clean and tidy. The litter pickers often help out after community events to help keep Dawlish tidier!
